## **PROJECT WORK**

### **Input-Process-Output Cycles : Uttarakhand and Karnataka**

Analyze and document three Input-Process-Output (IPO) cycles found in the traditional practices, industries, or daily lives of two Indian states: Uttarakhand and Karnataka. For example, Karnataka is very famous for filter coffee. For its production, Input is coffee beans and hot water, Process is filtering of the coffee, and Output is hot filter coffee.

General Instructions:
